Rules for Micro Allotment holders:

It is the responsibility of holders to water and look after (keep clean and tidy) the allotment plots they are responsible for.

If pesticides of any kind are being used, they must be organic sprays or powders. All gardening equipment, tools or waste materials are to be taken off site when leaving.

Rules for Keyham Green Places (CROPS):

It is the responsibility of holders to water and look after (keep clean and tidy) the allotment plots they are responsible for.

If pesticides of any kind are being used, they must be organic sprays or powders. All gardening equipment, tools or waste materials are to be taken off site when leaving.

Rules for CROPS

If a micro allotment holder cannot look after their plot(s) if CROPS is informed we will do our best to water and care for the plots on your behalf.

Some garden tools may be available for borrowing onsite; however, if these are lost or broken they will need to be either replaced or paid for.

Water is available FREE from CROPS but only watering cans may be used. No watering hoses are to be used unless permission has been granted by staff or trustees. If water is used from our tap the tap must be turned off immediately after filling any watering can. If water was left on to gush indiscriminately the person doing so would be responsible and CROPS may seek compensation in extreme cases.

In the centre gardens blackberries can be picked by anyone and families are encouraged to do so. With regards to apples any apples on the floor may be taken. No apples can be picked or other produce taken without the express permission from CROPS - either staff or trustees. Any produce grown in the micro allotments belongs to the owners of this agreement and cannot be used by anyone else without their permission.
